has been proposed that the most important unresolved issue of sad research is the definition of seasonality furthermore seasonality is a scientifically interesting construct because it implies a unique trait of mood variability in the context of environmental changes as such the investigation of seasonality provides a test of current understandings of the relationship between personality mood and affective vulnerability the second aim of the research therefore was to situate seasonality in the nomological web of trait constructs the third aim was to test a novel hypothesis about the psychobiology of the trait of neuroticism a hypothesis that derived from the integration of seasonality into the nomological net of personality constructs the key dependent variable in the research was mood and therefore a fourth aim was to investigate a contemporary model of mood by testing the hypothesis that a positive affect system is partially driven by biological rhythms
